

DIAMOND PEEL TREATMENT – MICRODERMABRASION

What is diamond peel treatment?

Diamond peel treatment is a microdermabrasion procedure, where we peel the epidermis gradually and under control with laser-shaped diamond tips and a vacuum.

During the procedure, we remove the dead skin cells, stimulate microcirculation, and the skin's rejuvenation. The duration of the treatment depends on the age of the client, skin type, and any problems in the area under consideration.

The procedure takes 20–40 minutes, and may be combined with moisturizing and regenerative cures. It may be repeated every 2–5 days. Diamond peel treatment can be performed on the face, back, hands and bust-line.

The procedure is completely pain-free and is suitable for anyone who wants to improve the appearance of their skin and prevent premature ageing.

Diamond peel treatment improves the skin condition with:

- impure skin;
- dilated pores;
- very tiny wrinkles;
- reduced skin tone.

The procedure is intended for:

- persons with all skin types who would like a fresh and glowing skin tone;
- all types of acne (except inflamed);
- anti-ageing of the skin.

Results after the procedure:

- fewer small and shallow wrinkles;
- restored skin;
- reduced pores;
- glowing skin.

After the procedure

After the procedure, the skin is slightly sensitive and sometimes a little red. We recommend that you avoid exposure to the sun without a hat and use a sunscreen with a high SPF for several days after the procedure. It is important that you do not apply make-up until the following day.

We do not carry out the treatment:

- with reddish skin and skin that is susceptible to rosacea;
- prior to exposure to the sun;
- during pregnancy;
- during the administration of certain hormone-related medications after a consultation with a dermatologist;
- in the event of treatment of various skin disturbances;
- with patients with anticoagulant therapy.

Prior to the examination, you must also fill out the Informed Consent form together with the doctor as regulated by the Patient Rights Act and the Doctor's Duty to Obtain an Informed Consent. The rules for filling out the form and the statement are presented upon your arrival at our institution.
