

WHAT IS FOTONA FracRevive®?

FracRevive® is an effective, minimally invasive, two-step rejuvenation therapy performed with both a full laser beam and a fractional beam of the Q-switched Nd:YAG laser. The therapy improves the appearance and texture of the skin, reducing pore size, pigmentation and static wrinkles. It is used to rejuvenate and improve the appearance of the skin. The procedure is also safe for dark skin tones.

WHICH LASER DO WE USE?

Fotona Starwalker MaQX.

HOW IS THE TREATMENT PERFORMED?

Clean the skin and protect the eyes with laser goggles. The laser procedure is performed in two steps.

In the first step, the skin is superheated with a full MaQX Nd:YAG mode laser beam, while in the second step, the minimally ablative cold FracTAT® technology is used. We make two passes, with two additional passes in the areas with large pores, pigmentation and uneven complexion. The treatment can be repeated after four to six weeks.

During the procedure, heat is felt in the first part and fractional photoacoustic waves are heard in the second.

After the procedure, the skin is red and minimally damaged, possibly with minor bleeding, and heals within five days.

HOW MANY REPETITIONS ARE NECESSARY?

For optimal results, one treatment per month is recommended, three to four times in a row, followed by one to three maintenance treatments per year, or individually, depending on the skin condition.

THE SUCCESS OF THE PROCEDURE

Improved skin appearance and texture are visible after just one treatment; we recommend four treatments for optimal results. Once the desired improvement is achieved, the treatment can be repeated every four to six months to maintain it.

CONTRAINDICATIONS OR FOR WHOM IS THE PROCEDURE NOT SUITABLE?

For pregnant women and those who are hypersensitive to light, have active inflammation on the face or take phototoxic drugs.

SIDE EFFECTS AND COMPLICATIONS

Rarely, redness and swelling may occur after the procedure, which generally subside within a day or two. Very rarely, pigmentation disorders or infections, such as herpes outbreaks, can occur.

POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

Applying a renewal cream several times a day is recommended due to the dry feeling of the skin, as well as consistent sun protection. On the first day, there may be redness, mild burning and, very rarely, swelling. On the second day, small scabs appear, which peel off within three to four days.

You can generally return to work or your daily activities between one and five days after the procedure.

Prior to the examination, you must also fill out the Informed Consent form together with the doctor as regulated by the Patient Rights Act and the Doctor's Duty to Obtain an Informed Consent. The rules for filling out the form and the statement are presented upon your arrival at our institution.
