

WHAT IS FOTONA LIPLASE?

Safe, gentle, fast and non-invasive laser procedure for fuller, less chapped and dry lips without the use of fillers. Stimulates collagen renewal and production. Lips become tighter, fuller and smoother; the incidence of herpes is reduced.

The procedure is also suitable for women with full lips who want to maintain that volume, as the collagen it produces diminishes over the years, and for men who want less chapped lips.

WHICH LASER DO WE USE?

Fotona SP Dynamis.

HOW IS THE TREATMENT PERFORMED?

The lips are cleaned, the eyes are protected with laser goggles, and the procedure is performed. During the procedure, there is warmth and an occasional stinging, slight burning sensation, which quickly subsides.

After the procedure, the skin on the lips does not appear damaged. Very rarely, swelling and minimal peeling may occur. If desired, an anaesthetic cream is applied before the procedure.

HOW MANY REPETITIONS ARE NECESSARY?

For optimal results, one treatment per month is recommended, three to four times in a row, then once or twice a year, or individually, depending on the condition of the lip skin.

THE SUCCESS OF THE PROCEDURE

After the first treatment, the lips are already tighter, fuller and more radiant; even more intense effects gradually appear over three to four months, with the maximum visible effect after six months. Four treatments are recommended for optimal results.

CONTRAINDICATIONS OR FOR WHOM IS THE PROCEDURE NOT SUITABLE?

For pregnant women and those who are hypersensitive to light, have active inflammation on the face or take phototoxic drugs.

SIDE EFFECTS AND COMPLICATIONS

After the procedure, you may experience redness, swelling, a transient feeling of dryness and peeling of the lips, which usually subside within a few days.

POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

Applying a nourishing lip balm or Vaseline several times a day and consistent sun protection are recommended. Smoking is discouraged.

You can return to work or your daily activities immediately after the procedure.

Prior to the examination, you must also fill out the Informed Consent form together with the doctor as regulated by the Patient Rights Act and the Doctor's Duty to Obtain an Informed Consent. The rules for filling out the form and the statement are presented upon your arrival at our institution.
