

WHAT IS MESOTHERAPY?

Mesotherapy is a deep moisturising treatment using a gel of non-crosslinked hyaluronic acid injected deep into the skin of the face, neck, décolletage, backs of the hands and other parts of the body.

WHICH PRODUCTS DO WE USE?

Products from various manufacturers are used, e.g. Juvederm, Teoxane, Neauvia.

HOW IS THE TREATMENT PERFORMED?

An anaesthetic cream is applied to make the procedure more comfortable, then a very fine needle is used to inject the product deep into the skin.

HOW MANY REPETITIONS ARE NECESSARY?

The number of repetitions depends on the product chosen. The procedure is carried out once a month, three times in a row, and then the cycle is repeated after 6–12 months. There is also a product applied only once every six months.

THE SUCCESS OF THE PROCEDURE

After the first injection, the skin is more toned, moisturised and radiant.

CONTRAINDICATIONS OR FOR WHOM IS THE PROCEDURE NOT SUITABLE?

The procedure should not be performed on pregnant women, breastfeeding mothers, children and persons with untreated epilepsy, chronic or acute inflammation of the skin at the injection site, known allergy to the ingredient of the product, serious organic and systemic diseases, including autoimmune diseases, persons prone to hypertrophic scarring, bleeding disorders, or bleeding tendencies. Special care is needed for people taking anti-clotting medication, as bleeding or bruising may occur at the site of the procedure. Caution should be taken if anticoagulants are taken and if there is any allergy to the anaesthetic.

SIDE EFFECTS AND COMPLICATIONS

For a few days, you may see small bumps, which will disappear. Mild bleeding, transient bruising may be present.

POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

The patient can start using own cosmetics the next day, with using powder foundation to cover any bruising. No sauna is recommended 14 days after the procedure.

You can return to work or your daily activities in one to three days.

Prior to the examination, you must also fill out the Informed Consent form together with the doctor as regulated by the Patient Rights Act and the Doctor's Duty to Obtain an Informed Consent. The rules for filling out the form and the statement are presented upon your arrival at our institution.
