

WHAT IS PLATELET-RICH PLASMA (PRP) SCALP THERAPY?

It's a therapy using the patient's own platelet-rich plasma, which is extracted from the patient's own blood and injected into the problem area. It is used to stimulate hair growth due to its high concentration of growth factors, cytokines and signalling molecules. The PRP therapy improves microcirculation and scalp metabolism, reduces hair loss and speeds up scalp rehabilitation after hair transplantation.

WHICH TUBES DO WE USE?

Plasmolifting TM.

HOW IS THE TREATMENT PERFORMED?

First, blood is taken from the patient, from which a special procedure is used to obtain the patient's own platelet-rich plasma (PRP), which appears as a yellowish liquid. Before injecting into the treatment area (e.g. face, neck, backs of hands, scalp, etc.), the area is lubricated with anesthetic cream to make the injections as painless as possible.

HOW MANY REPETITIONS ARE NECESSARY?

The hair growth acceleration treatment is carried out every four weeks, three to six times in a row, and then can be repeated after six months.

THE SUCCESS OF THE PROCEDURE

Several processes are needed to achieve the results. The effect can be seen several months after the last injection.

CONTRAINDICATIONS OR FOR WHOM IS THE PROCEDURE NOT SUITABLE?

The procedure should not be performed in pregnant women and breastfeeding mothers, persons with blood diseases, autoimmune urticaria, systemic skin disease, current oncological disease, acute inflammation, allergy to heparin sodium, taking anti-clotting medications.

SIDE EFFECTS AND COMPLICATIONS

There are often puncture marks visible after the procedure; bruising may occur and resolve within a week. Occasionally, there may be swelling, pain, headache and a feeling of pressure, which may subside within a few hours or a day. Very rarely, hyperpigmentation and infection may occur.

POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

It's not recommended to use sauna or wash your hair with hot water for 14 days after the procedure.

With PRP scalp treatment, you go back to work or daily activities immediately.

Prior to the examination, you must also fill out the Informed Consent form together with the doctor as regulated by the Patient Rights Act and the Doctor's Duty to Obtain an Informed Consent. The rules for filling out the form and the statement are presented upon your arrival at our institution.
