

WHAT IS SKIN REJUVENATION WITH SKINBOOSTERS?

It is a procedure where thermally stabilised ultra-pure hyaluronic acid of high and low molecular weight is injected into the skin. Boosters hydrate and nourish the skin from the inside out – their main function is to deeply moisturise, while stimulating collagen production and improving the skin's texture, radiance and elasticity. They are used on the face, neck, décolletage and backs of the hands. The result is immediately visible and improves over time.

WHICH PRODUCTS DO WE USE?

Profhilo is used.

HOW IS THE TREATMENT PERFORMED?

First, an anaesthetic cream is applied, then a very fine needle is used to inject a stimulant into a few points on the skin and a regenerating cream is applied.

HOW MANY REPETITIONS ARE NECESSARY?

The treatment is carried out once a month, twice in a row, and then every 6 to 12 months as needed to maintain the condition of the skin.

THE SUCCESS OF THE PROCEDURE

The result is immediately visible and improves over time, lasting up to 12 months.

CONTRAINDICATIONS OR FOR WHOM IS THE PROCEDURE NOT SUITABLE?

The procedure should not be performed on pregnant women, breastfeeding mothers, children and persons with untreated epilepsy, known allergy to the ingredient of the product, chronic or acute inflammation of the skin at the injection site, serious organic and systemic diseases, including autoimmune diseases, persons prone to hypertrophic scarring, bleeding disorders, or bleeding tendencies. Special care is needed for people taking anti-clotting medication, as bleeding or bruising may occur at the site of the procedure. You should warn your doctor in case you are taking anti-clotting medication.

SIDE EFFECTS AND COMPLICATIONS

For a few days, a small lump may be visible at the injection site, which can be massaged and will disappear within a few days. Occasionally, swelling and redness occur, which resolve within a few days. Light bleeding and transient bruising may be present. The following complications are described in the literature as extremely rare: the possibility of allergic reactions, infections, nodes and granulomas, and skin discoloration or necrosis.

POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS

Treated area must not be touched for 24 hours to prevent infection. Drink plenty of water or tea.

Only the prescribed restorative cream should be applied for one to two days. You can start using your cosmetics once any redness and swelling have completely resolved.

Sauna and extreme physical activity are not recommended for 14 days; protect yourself from the sun with a wide-brimmed hat and SPF50 sunscreen.

Any bruising can be covered with powder foundation the day after the procedure.

You can return to work or your daily activities in one to three days.

Prior to the examination, you must also fill out the Informed Consent form together with the doctor

as regulated by the Patient Rights Act and the Doctor's Duty to Obtain an Informed Consent. The rules for filling out the form and the statement are presented upon your arrival at our institution.
